Launched in December 2016, Fiordland Discovery is a family-owned and run business, with the owners having a lifelong connection to Fiordland. The idea behind Fiordland Discovery is to offer visitors up-close-and-personal access to one of New Zealand's most iconic National Parks, through operators that have a genuine connection to the area.

With this in mind, Rob designed and built the Fiordland Jewel, a 24m high-spec catamaran that features a helipad, top-deck hot tub, nine climate-controlled cabins all with ensuite bathrooms and majestic fiord and sea views. With an on board chef, comfortable and elegant dining and seating areas, and genuine Kiwi hospitality, Fiordland Jewel provides a truly special way to experience the incredible beauty of Fiordland.










